1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020(RRS)*.
- 1.2 The class rules of the Int. H-Boot Class will apply
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between languages the english text will take precedence.
- 1.4 Every person on board who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall have the appropriate license.
- 1.5 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at the regatta office at the ARZV clubhouse.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the H-Boot class.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and sending it, together with the required fee, to www.alkmaardermeer.nl

4 FEES

- 4.1 Required fee is € 99,00

5.2* A minimum of 5 races have to be completed to make the total result of the event counting for the H-Boot year prize 2018.

5.3 On the last day of the regatta, if fewer than 5 races have been completed, the last warning signal can be at 13:30.

6 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate on registration. In addition equipment may be inspected or measured on the water.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on June 23, after 8.00 hrs at the Race office.

8 VENUE

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be:

Up- downwind course, with a spreader mark upwind and a gate downwind (type WA, Appendix S RRS).

The target time of each race will be 50 min.

10 SCORING

10.1 Five races are required to constitute a series.

- 10.2** (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When 5 or 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be marked with their national flag. They are not allowed to come closer than 50m to any point of the racing area.

12 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places, directed from the harbourmaster.

13 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

14 PRIZES

Prizes will be made available to the first 3 teams of the overall standing

There will be a perpetual prize for the winner of the series.

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4 RRS, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 per event or the equivalent.
